

# **Club Rally Reports**





## **Location: MILANG**

Date of Rally: 9-14 November No of Vans: 15 (Adults 28)

**Expenses Incurred:** 

Park Fees \$27 per night (no deposit)

Total site fees: \$1600

Other Expenses: \$800 Total spend at rally: \$2400

**On arrival**: The manager gave each person a map, showed them the rough area set aside for the Club and left everyone to themselves. Then we had to turn off the sprinklers and wait for the flooded sites to dry out a bit before setting up.

**The park and surrounds**: Green grass, shade but a bit "shabby" looking—too many semi-derelict permanents.

Things we did at this rally: Had a great meal at the hotel. New manager was extra friendly, food was good and served very quickly from pre-taken orders. Afternoon tea in the railway carriage, a visit to the bakery, walking tour of the town, visit to Finniss for lunch and to the Langhorne Creek Hotel for lunch were highlights.

Recommended as a destination although the park itself is rather disappointing in cleanliness, tidiness and presentation.

## **Location: PORT WILLUNGA**

Date of Rally: Dec 7-11 No of Vans: 15 Cabins: 1 (Adults 32) Expenses Incurred:

Park Fees \$40 per night (1 night deposit required)

Total site fees: \$2800

Other Expenses: \$700 Total spend at rally: \$3500

On arrival: No issues. All sites ready for us. Most only on

wood chips/mulch.

The park and surrounds: Neat, well kept but still bush camping near the city. Amenities kept clean. Nice pool but needs a heater!

Things we did at this rally: This was our Christmas rally so we had planned dinner under the gazebos, but the weather did a full 360 and from 40 degree heat on Thursday, we had torrential rain on the Saturday and gale force winds on the Sunday. Many trees came down in the park on Sunday but fortunately our members had moved from one of them before a massive branch fell. We still successfully celebrated with a lovely meal on Saturday night in the camp kitchen and a cake for the 50th birthday of the Club on the Sunday.

## MIDDLETON CARAVAN PARK

Date of rally:  $20^{th} - 27^{th}$  OCTOBER 2023

Three caravans with six members

Fees \$30.00 per night **Total site fees:** \$630

On arrival: The sites were very nice and well grassed.

This park and surrounds: I cannot stress how strongly I can say "Do not use this Park". The Manageress is not friendly and extremely rude and is rarely on site. She will not answer the phone and will not accept credit card payments, telling customers she does not have the facilities. We later found out from a customer that happened to arrive off the street on one of the few times she was in the office, that they paid on their card. Customers including us were not informed renovations were in progress and both sexes had to use the one facility as the mens was closed. Most of the time we were booked in there was one shower open for up to 12 vans. The cabin situation is as bad as we learned from people in them.

**Things we did at the rally:** There are plenty of things to do and places to see around the area.

## Coobowie Caravan Park

**Date of rally:** 10<sup>th</sup> – 17<sup>th</sup> November 2023 8 caravans and 2 cabins. 18 adults and 2 visitors.

**Expenses incurred:** 

Park powered sites \$28 per day.

Total site fees: \$1568

On arrival: This is a nice park with good clean facilities and

dump point.

The park and surrounds: The Camp Kitchen is well stocked with good appliances and three BBQ's inside. All very good for inclement weather. All sites are clean and well grassed and maintained. The Staff are very efficient and friendly.

Things we did at this rally: We travelled extensively on the Peninsula sight seeing and had great morning tea and cakes every place tried by our members. All went to the Coobowie Hotel for lunch on Tuesday and not a complaint about the food or service. The fishing from the Edithburgh jetty was not as good this time as in the past.

We would recommend this park to all Clubs or travelers.
